

A Brief History:

As a matter of fact, Amar Manikya, a well-known Manikya ruler of Tripura was associated with nthis land. Government Degree college, Amarpur as a coeducational institution of higher education was established on 1st September, 1998 to meet the emerging needs of students and local people.initially, the college started its journey in the school of building of Govt. Higher Secondary school for boys at amarpur in the morning shift. Later on, the location of this college was shifted to present site of Kawamara, amarpur, Gomati Tripura district on 12th Dec. 2002. This college has received recognition from the University Grant commission (UGC) under 2(f) and 12(B) on 17th Nov. 2009. The college has been renamed as Adwaita Malla Barman smriti Mahavidyalaya in the year 2014.

At present, the college has been offering three years degree program in arts both in honours such as Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Education, History, Political Science and Philosophy and pass in above mentioned subjects including Kokoborok, Science stream(Pure Science) has been introduced in the year 2017 with intake capacity of 10 students. UGC sponsored programme such as remedial coaching, cell for SC/ST/OBC students, career and counseling cell, coaching for first service entry in service are functioning for the betterment of the students in the field of higher education.

Aim of the college: To deliver education to the students and to use modern technology in delivering lectures in the classrooms.

Vision: To establish A.M.B.S. Mahavidyalaya, Amarpur, the highest institution of the quality education in the state.

- Any student passing H.S(+2) examination or its equivalent with at least 4 subjects including English from any recognized Board/Council shall be eligible for admission to the 1st semester of the B.A.(Honours/General) or B.Sc (General) programme of studies subject to availability of seats and restrictions of combinations of subjects as laid down in clause-5 and provided that he/she has secured in that examination, at least
 - a. 40% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject in which he/she seeks Honours.

or

b. 35% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in the concerned subject (Group & Course).




- c. Any one securing at least 50% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for taking honours in a subject, which he/she did not study in H.S(+2) examination or its equivalent, subject to restrictions of combination of subjects. (In regards to marks bar for admission against reserved seats/ quotas for ST/SC/PH/OBC candidates/instructions of UGC will be followed from time to time.)
- 2. No students shall be allowed for admission in to 1st Semester course for studies after a lapse of more than 5 (Five) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.
- 3. A student shall not be allowed to take honours in a subject in which he/she has failed in its H.S(+2) examination or its equivalent but subsequently pass as a compartmental candidate.
- 4. A student shall not be allowed to offer more than two languages subjects as a elective i.e. any one from English, Bengali and Kokborok and another one Sanskrit. However, the college authority may further restrict the choice of combination of subjects according to infrustuctural facilities and faculties available in the concerned collge.


- 5. Subject taken as honours shall not be taken as an elective subjects.
- 6. A student shall have to apply with one copy of recent passport size photo for University registration in prescribe form 30 days from the last date of admission. No application for registration will be entertain after the expiry of this stipulated period.
- 7. A student shall be allowed to change subjects(s)/stream within 15 days from his/her admission to the college, subject to the restriction of combination of subjects laid down by the respective college. No such change shall be entertain once application for university registration is forwarded to the University from the college.
