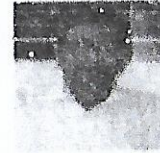

**Forwarding of Report in respect of National Level Webinar
On
National Education Policy 2020**

I am too glad to inform you that the Department of Education of the college has organized a one day national level webinar on National Education Policy 2020 in our college on 19th September 2020 through virtual mode.

In this webinar the participants of different backgrounds like students, teachers, scholars and resource persons of different fields were invited for outreach to every stakeholder of our society.

First of all Sri Patai Kumar Murasing, the Organizing Secretary of this Webinar focused on National Education Policy 2020. He welcomed all the dignitaries; Chief Guest, Chief Patron, Resource Persons and all the participants who have joined this virtual mode of National Webinar. He touched all the main topics pertaining to the National Education Policy.

In this webinar Director of Higher Education, Sri Saju Vaheed IAS, was ^{the} Chief Patron. Professor Satyadeo Poddar, Vice Chancellor, Maharaja Bir Bikram University, Agartala, also presented as Chief Patron in this webinar.

Shri Saju Vaheed, IAS, Chief Patron of this Webinar wished all the best for the success of this National Webinar. He expressed his views that being a rural area this college has endeavoured to carry out this type of educational webinar which is the positive side of National Education Policy 2020.

Professor Satyadeo Podder, Vice Chancellor, Maharaja Bir Bikram University focussed on Autonomous Degree College, Private Public Partnership types of college etc.

Professor Podder highlighted in his speech that Autonomous Degree Colleges will be established and autonomy will be given to the college as per the provisions of the New Education Policy 2020. And the Colleges will be provided to grant and offer the Degree.

Private Public Partnership will have more values to upgrade the educational quality.

He recalled the ancient Indian Education system and emphasized that students used to attend all round development in Nalanda and Taxila University. The holistic education was provided to the pupils.

He mentioned that the main objective of the NEP 2020 is to create ^{Good} human beings by which all conflicts will be managed in a peaceful atmosphere. The students will attend the character building.

He emphasized that it is the first in the History of India that students of 3 years of age will go to the school and receive the education through the play way method.

He made it clear that in previous education commissions no emphasis on mother tongue has been given but NEP 2020 talks about the language of the locality by which the students can get their basic knowledge in their mother tongue only.

He talked about that it is due to the efficiency of NEP 2020 that vocational education will be imparted to the students by which the livelihood problem will be solved.

He talked about that NEP 2020 will make our past glory dignified and again India will become Viswa Guru.

He focused on the essence of the National Research foundation by which all the research work will be carried out in one platform only.

Professor Podder made clear that NEP 2020 will bring all the changes in our education system and India will become far ahead in quality education and quality research. Overall holistic education will be provided to students which will help them to become good human beings full of character.

The Presidential address was given by Dr. Pradeep Kumar Deepak, Principal In Charge, Adwaita Malla Barman Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Amarpur. First of all, he welcomed the Chief Patron, Chief Guest, and Resource persons and all the dignitaries and participants of the National Webinar on "National Education Policy".

He talked about the essence of the National Webinar in the present scenario. He expressed his views that this National Education Policy 2020 gives more emphasis on early childhood education starting from the age of 3 years of age, which is the excellent approach of education to all. Now, the education system will be on 5+3+3+4 system, whereas the present educational setup is on 10+2+3. Initially the kids will be provided their early education in play-way method and up to class 2 there will be no exam. After that primary education will be in the mother tongue. At 6th class, the student will take vocational education and this will lead them to get a job as per their choice after completing their education.

As a whole, he discussed in brief about the quality education and quality research in his speech. He told that tradition and values will make our students ahead in moral education. He narrated that through NEP 2020, India will again regain the palce of pioneer in educational set-up in the entire world.

He discussed the National Research Foundation, by which research work will find more importance in NEP 2020. He said that we are proud of our ancient universities like Nalanda, Vikramshila and Taxila.

At last, he thanked all the dignitaries and participants and told that National Education Policy 2020 is the best education policy after the independence of India from British dominion. He wished all the best for the success of the webinar and in this manner, the inaugural session ended.

The technical session of the National Webinar started with a speech of Dr. Chandra Shekhar Pillai, Associate Professor, BBMC, Agartala. He had delivered a very valuable and informative speech on NEP 2020. He started his speech by elaborating previous National Commissions of education and National Policies. He said that the British ruled India for more than 200 years and designed educational policies of India after independence.

He focused that NEP 2020 talks about the formal education which will cater for the education of 3 years old children whereas previous commissions had talked about 6 years of age to get formal education.

He emphasized that this is the first time ICT enabled education is proposed to be imparted in a better manner.

He said that the significance of this NEP 2020 is that 6% of GDP will be incurred on education which is a revolutionary step in the field of education.

He expressed his views that Anganwadi will be given more importance by this NEP 2020. He said that lots of emphasis should be given on the infrastructure of the Anganwadi so that the students of 3 years of age can get better opportunities of education in Play Way mode. Really this type of pre-primary education will boost the morale of small kids to learn by planning methods. He clarified all the doubts raised by the participants in the chat box.

The next resource person was Dr. Naveen Kumar, Asst. Professor, NEHU, Shillong. His topic of discussion was "The Role of National Education Policy 2020 in the 21st Century with special reference to Higher Education". He expressed his views in a better manner and discussed in a better manner and discussed in detail about the various education policies, education commissions and justified the rule of National Education Policy 2020 in the 21st century. He stated his talk from the division of NEP 2020 in 4 parts and clarified that NEP 2020 will meet the challenges of 21st century in terms of digital preparedness, intelligence, machinery learning, digital ethics, cultural studies and blended learning.

He had touched upon all the main provisions of NEP 2020 and talked about the significance of our cultural past, where ancient Indian tradition was regarded as the

pioneer in every aspect and the same thing will find its place in National Education Policy 2020.

Dr. Naveen Kumar has expressed his views that the sole motto of education is to build the character, which is to build the character, which finds top-most place in NEP 2020. He discussed that holistic education must be given to all students.

As a matter of fact, the lecture of Dr. Naveen Kumar was based on the significance of technology in the modern educational system. He also talked about the quality education and quality research and expressed his views that the National Education Policy 2020 will enable India as "Vishwa Guru".

The program was scheduled for 2 and half hours. The program ended with Vote of Thanks by Dr. Prabir Datta, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science of the College along with the National Anthem by Mrs. Keya Das, Assistant Professor, and Department of Bengali of the College.
