



Report on Non-Formal Sanskrit Education

RASHTRIYA SANSKRIT SANSTHAN, New Delhi (Deemed University) has sanctioned a 'Non-Formal Sanskrit Education Centre' in AdwaitaMalla Barman Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Amarapur, Gomati, Tripura, in the year 2017-2018. The objective of this course is to speak Sanskrit fluently and to give students a taste of Sanskrit as a living language by introducing them to its basic grammatical structures so that they can start understanding simple texts as well as allow them to use it in daily life like reading and understanding of Gita, Ramayana, Ayurveda etc. So far 36 learners 15 boys 16 girls of the different department and 05 staff member of this college have registered for this course. And 20 learners (12 boys 05 girls) from different semester of different department and 03 staff members were successfully completed. A set of 5 textbooks provided to the learner FREE of cost by the Sansthan (New Delhi).The non formal Sanskrit education centre was inaugurated in our college on 26.09.2017. On this occasion, the program was started with a 'Swarasati Vandana' prepared by the student of Sanskrit department. After that the welcome address given by Miss Nandita Debbarma, co-coordinator of non formal centre of this college. She highlighted the importance of Sanskrit language in her speech.



The program was presided over by the Dr. Pradeep Kr. Deepak, Principal-In-Charge of this collage. Principal, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Eklavya campus, Agartala, was the inaugurator of the program. Altogether 130 students and 28 teaching and non-teaching staff actively participated. In avoidance of hampering the regular classes, the Non-Formal classes were conducted mainly in the afternoon sessions only. But in 2017 the course was incomplete in our college due to the unauthorized leave taken by the non formal teacher and he did not join. Then the remaining 2017 year batch course was continued in the next session (2018) and was completed in the year 2019 by a new teacher Mr. Gadhadar Padhan, which was allotted to the centre by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi. And this certificate course in Sanskrit language would be continued for the next ten (10) months for popularizing spoken Sanskrit as well as Sanskrit culture.
