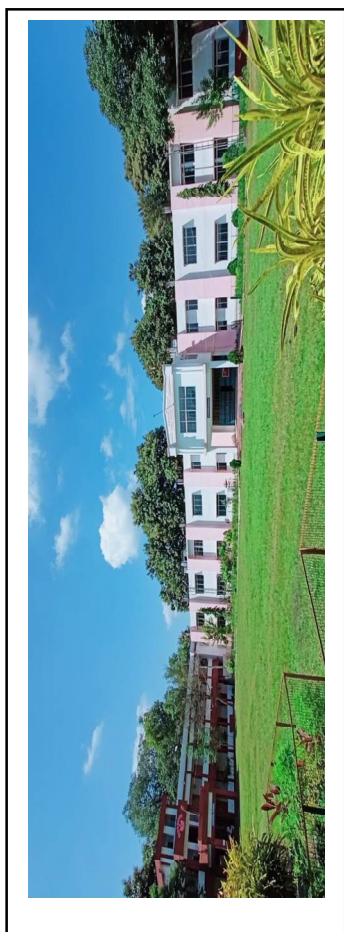

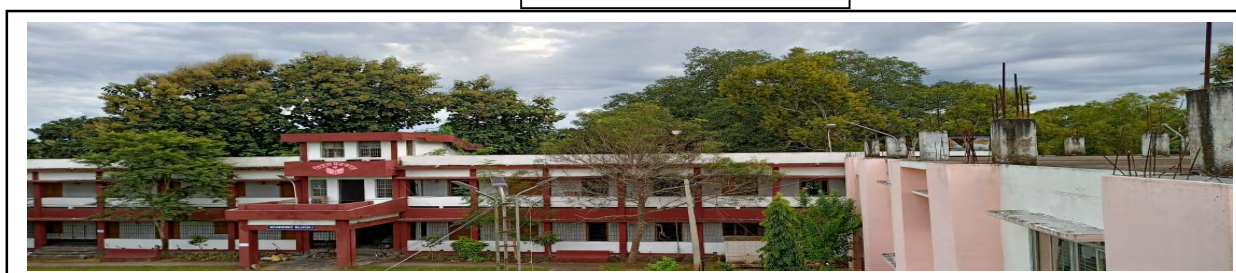


Academic Main building (New)

### **A Brief History:**

As a matter of fact, Amar Manikya, a well-known Manikya Dynasty ruler of Tripura was associated with this precious land. Government Degree college, Amarpur, as a co-educational institution of higher education was established on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 1998 to meet the emerging needs of students and local people. Initially, the college started its journey in the school building of Amarpur Boys Higher Secondary School, Govt. of Tripura, at Amarpur. The college began its academic session in the morning shift. Later on, 12<sup>th</sup> December 2002 the college shifted from Amarpur Boys Higher Secondary School to present location at Kawamaraghat, Amarpur, Gomati district, Tripura. The college has received recognition from the University Grant commission (UGC) under 2(f) and 12(B) on 17<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2009. In the year 2014, the college has been renamed as Adwaita Malla Barman Smriti Mahavidyalaya.

At present, the college has been offering three years degree program in arts stream both in Honours as well as General in the following subjects as Honours - Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Education, History, Political Science and Philosophy as well as Kokborok and NCC as elective subjects. In the year 2017, Science Stream (Pure Science) has been introduced with intake capacity of 10 students.

This is a proud moment that Govt. of Tripura has adopted and introduced National Education Policy-2020 from this academic session in all General Degree College. On 9th June 2023, Dr Manik Saha, Hon' ble Chief Minister, Government of Tripura inaugurated NEP 2020. Accordingly this college is also going to introduced NEP-2020 which is four year degree programme, categorically certificate in faculty, Diploma in faculty, Bachelor in faculty with single Major and Bachelor in faculty (Honours) in Major.

For bringing student into Excellency, this college also pertaining UGC sponsored programme such as remedial coaching, cell for SC/ST/OBC students, career and counseling cell, coaching for competitive exam for entry in different civil services as well for pursuing higher education. Beside that to upbringing the students the college also conduct seminar, workshop and hands-on programme. The faculties are highly competent in teaching as well as teaching with advanced technology in the classroom.

## Rules & Regulation for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> semester (As per NEP-2020):

1. Admission process will be conducted in offline mode for the academic session 2023-2024 at the college.
2. **Eligibility for Admission:**
  - i. Any student passing the Higher Secondary/H.S.(+2)/ senior Secondary Examination or its equivalent from any recognized Board/ Council shall be eligible for admission through admission process conducted by Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of Tripura to the First Semester of the Under Graduate (B.A./B.Sc.) programme of studies subject to availability of seats.  
(Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.)
  - ii. For B.Sc programmes, a candidate who passed 10+2 with Science or equivalent shall be eligible for admission.
  - iii. A candidates opting subjects like Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as Major subject in the B.Sc programme must have passed Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as prerequisites subjects at the qualifying examinations.
3. A student shall have to apply with one copy of recent passport size photo for University registration in prescribe form 30 days from the last date of admission. No application for registration will be entertain after the expiry of this stipulated period.
4. A student shall be allowed to change subjects(s)/stream within 15 days from his/her admission to the college, subject to the restriction of combination of subjects laid down by the respective college. No such change shall be entertain once application for university registration is forwarded to the University from the college.
5. Regarding relaxation of minimum marks for admission against reserves seats/quotes for SC/ST/PWD/OBC and other candidates, the guidelines/ instructions of GOI/UGC issued from time to time will be followed.
6. All the candidates are required to submit the self-attested photo copy of the following documents along with the application form duly filled:
